OPHTHALMOLOGY FELLOWSHIP OPPORTUNITY FOR INTERNAL CANDIDATES

Applications are invited from the staff members of Ispahani Islamia Eye Institute and Hospital for the 18-month Long Term Fellowship in **Neuro-ophthalmology**. The next course will commence from **1st July, 2026**.

Academic and professional qualification:

(1) Candidates who have an M.S./F.C.P.S./ any equivalent degree in Ophthalmology recognized by BMDC, they need to have at least one-year service experience in IIEI&H after postgraduation. (2) Candidates who have DO or equivalent degree, they need to have at least two-year service experiences in IIEI&H after postgraduation. (3) The gap between two study leaves should be at least 01 (one) year of continuous service.

Other Requirements:

1. Age of the candidate should not exceed 45 years at the beginning of fellowship.
2. For candidates of secondary hospitals, applications should be forwarded to Director (MS) and HOD (HR) with intimation to Consultant-in charge and Director (CS).

Submission procedure (for internal candidates):

(1) The individual candidates have to forward or submit the application to Education Department with the endorsement of MS and HR department (2) Concerned department HODs (subspecialties) will give their recommendations during the interview/ selection process. (3) Selection will be made based on the potential of the candidates, his/her performance at IIEI&H and other factors as deemed necessary.

Service Bond:


A bond shall be executed to serve the Institute & Hospital for a minimum period of 03 (Three) years following successful completion of the Fellowship training. Failing this, fellows will be liable to compensate the Institute and Hospital the entire cost of the training including any salary that they may receive during the training period.

Restrictions: During the fellowship, fellows shall not undertake/ pursue any other course/ examination. They will not be permitted to do private practice or to be involved in any activity for monetary benefit in any form during the fellowship period. Violation of this rule may result in cancellation of the fellowship programme.

Selection for Fellowship will be made on a competitive basis based on the results of a written test (MCQ) and a subsequent interview. Written test and viva to be held on **12th May, 2026**.
