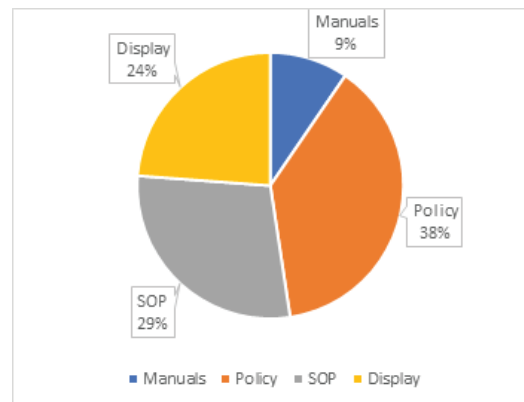
The Journey of Quality Assurance Department of Ispahani Islamia Eye Institute & Hospital

Ispahani Islamia Eye Institute and Hospital (IIEI&H) is a renowned eye care hospital in Bangladesh, located in Dhaka, and has a long history of providing eye care services to the community. Though the hospital's quality journey began when it was founded, but officially the Quality Assurance Department was established in January 2016. The Quality Assurance Department focuses on hospital structure and, the development of different policies, procedures, processes, and manuals that meet the hospital standards both at the national and international levels. This team plays a supporting role and spearheads in the field of Continuous Quality Improvement in the hospital. The department continuously monitors and assesses the quality of services, identifies areas for improvement, and implements strategies to enhance the patient experience and outcomes.

Establishing a robust quality management system is critical. This includes defining quality standards, developing policies and procedures, and implementing quality assurance mechanisms. IIEI&H has been trying to adopt international standards and also followed specific healthcare quality framework designs nationally by the DGHS. We are proud to share our achievements by developing various Policies, SOPs, Manuals etc. of the past few years as follows: (but not limited to the list)



- ❖ Clinical Practice Guidelines (CPG) for various Clinical Departments like CPG for GOPD, Cataract Clinic, and many more clinical departments in the pipeline.
- ❖ Safety Manual, Anesthesia Manual, IT Policy, Visitor and attendant Policy, Policy for Intellectual properties, policy for CCTV Surveillance, SOP for kitchen, food and beverage, etc.
- ❖ Patient Registration Form, Surgery Consent Form, Discharge Certificate, Surgical Safety Checklist, etc. developed and implemented.

A Continuous quality initiative of QAD is the Clinical Audit. Clinical Audit meetings play a crucial role in maintaining and improving the quality of eye care services. Clinical Audit meetings in IIEI&H are integral to the continuous improvement of services, ensuring patient safety, compliance with standards, and the overall effectiveness and efficiency of eye care delivery. The QAD of IIEI&H continually assess the clinical outcome, gather data, and fostering a culture of perpetual improvement.

IIEI&H's quality journey is never-ending, it's likely to be an ongoing process, with the commitment to continuous improvement to meet the eye care needs of its community and beyond. Over the period of time, a commitment to quality can lead to improved patient outcomes, increased trust from the community, and a positive reputation in the healthcare sector.

Infection Control Mechanism at IIEI&H

Ispahani Islamia Eye Institute & Hospital (IIEI&H) has a strong & proactive Hospital Infection Control Committee (HICC) headed by the Deputy Director Medical Service (Chairman of the ICC). There have been many practical and effective steps taken so far to reduce the risk of Hospital Acquired Infections (HAI) through comprehensive infection prevention and control program.

The Infection Prevention and Control program covers policies on hand hygiene, bio-medical waste management,

occupational health safety, infectious disease notification, environmental cleanliness, disinfection and sterilization, spillage management, needle stick injury (NSI), etc. The overall aim of the program is to prevent the spread of infections in healthcare facilities and settings; thereby assisting healthcare workers in the provision of quality healthcare in IIEI&H.

To maintain strict infection control compliance, we encourage all clinical staff to ensure good hand hygiene, surgical scrubbing, proper uses of PPE, the highest standard sterilization process, maintain environmental cleanliness including deep cleaning and fumigation process; proper disposal of Bio-medical waste, etc. All nursing staff attend regular infection control training to keep them up to date with the latest guidance for protecting patients. The dedicated Infection Control Nurse (ICN) regularly monitors all the hospital areas including the OT Complex for the potential spread of infections and advises suitable steps to prevent & control infections under the direction of the Chairman, ICC.

The Hospital Infection Control Committee reviews data on hospital infections, helps to identify program priorities, guides activities, supports best practices, and meets Infection Control Standards and regulations.

A-54 years Patient with Corneal Scar & VK: Good vision after Penetrating Keratoplasty (PK) Surgery

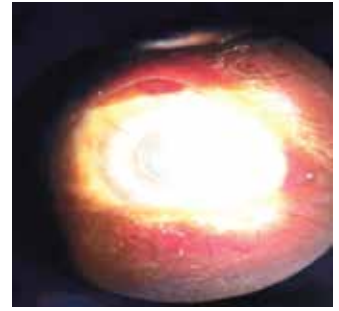
Case Report:

Ziaur Rahman, A 54-year-old man came to our hospital with complaints of chronic uveitis, suspected Glaucoma, and vascularized corneal scar due to Viral Keratitis (VK). After evaluation in the Cornea & Anterior Segment department of our hospital, we found that he had 6/6 vision in his right eye and HM in his left eye. In this situation, the patient may have an elevated risk of immunogenic rejection, an issue considered as exacerbated in higher-risk clinical scenarios such as herpetic infection, and a history of multiple graft failures. Our cornea and anterior segment surgeon suggested performing PK with PCIOL in his left eye on an urgent basis. After performing PK in his left eye,

the post-operative vision was 6/36 (unaided) and 6/12 (pinhole) respectively. This was a quite satisfactory outcome and a commendable performance of the entire team. We are proud of our “Cornea and Anterior Segment” department and its members.

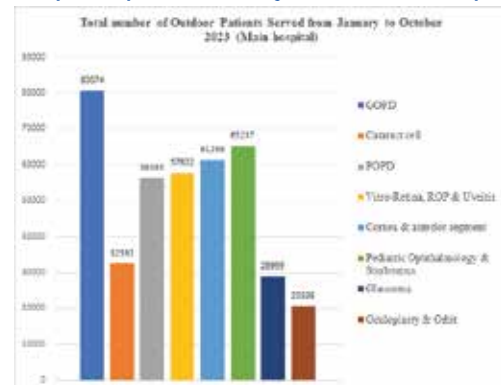


Figure 1: Total number of outdoor patients served from January to October 2023 in the main hospital

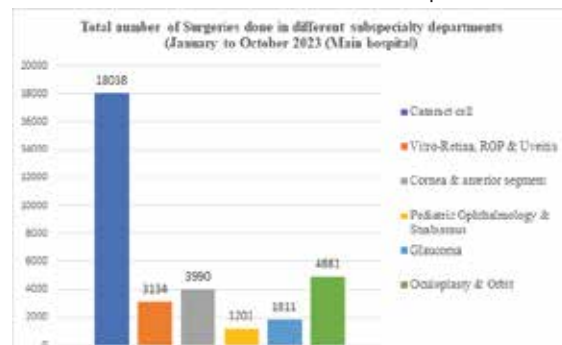


Figure 2: Total number of Surgeries done in different subspecialty departments (January to October 2023 at the main hospital).

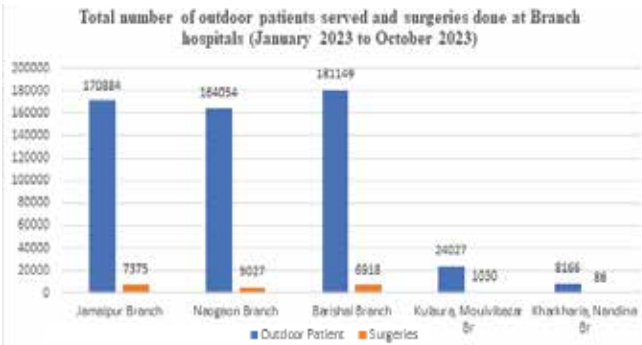


Figure 3: Total number of outdoor patients served and surgeries done at Branch hospitals (January 2023 to October 2023)

Experience of Dr. Angela Mokaya as a Foreign fellow at IIEI&H

I am Dr. Angela Mokaya, a general ophthalmologist from Kenya. I have had the privilege of participating in a short-term ophthalmology fellowship, focused on Phaco-emulsification cataract surgery, at Ispahani Islamia Eye Institute and Hospital. Over the course of 6 weeks, I had the opportunity to observe, assist and work with experienced ophthalmologists as my mentors. The initial phase of the training period takes place in the wet lab. This period was invaluable. During this time, using animal eyes, the training focused on the development of surgical skills, as well as gaining familiarity with cutting-edge Phaco-emulsification equipment. After this, during the clinical exposure period, and under the guidance of skilled mentors, I learned the art of patient selection, pre-operative assessment, and about the use of relevant advanced diagnostic tests. Through my placement in the operating theatre I learnt the surgical techniques involved in Phaco-emulsification, and also refined my Small Incision Cataract surgical skills, under close supervision of experienced ophthalmologists. Beyond surgical aspects, the entire staff complement in the operating theatres emphasizes the importance of aseptic theatre procedures, time and schedule management, and effective record-keeping. Post-operative care and discussion of potential complications of cataract surgery allowed me to appreciate the importance of patient outcomes and satisfaction. Every single day, I learned something of value from my mentors, from the experienced nursing staff, from my fellow students, from members of other departments and vital technical teams, such as the CSSD, the Biometry and OCT/Specular microscopy department, the Hospitality department, the list goes on. Perhaps the greatest takeaway for me is the collaborative workplace culture at Ispahani Islamia Eye Institute & Hospital. This culture of cooperation, communication, and a sense of shared responsibility was deeply impressed upon me. There is a feeling of collaboration between different departments, and the contribution of each member is valued.
